Revisions to the Data Governance Charter

I. Purpose

A. Program Responsibilities

Participating programs will adopt, communicate, and enforce the established data governance policies, procedures, processes, and standards at all levels of their program as data is an inter and intrægency asset. Paripating programs need to assign members to participate in each Data Governance Work GroWithin each DGWG, a consensated decisionmaking process will be utilized. Each participating program will have one unified voice in the-decision process.



First Five SC (portal address <u>https://first5sc.org</u>)

- 1. Officially launched February 17, 2022 A login system for programs to collect information for eligible families/leads was launched March 30, 2022.
- 2. Common application development is underway.
- 3. First Five SC has received hational attention from The Baby Monitor and the Alliance for Early Success. First Five SC will be featured on an upcoming podcast from PDG, as well as an episode of Carolina Classrooms on ETV, featuring Georgia Mjartan.
 - a. Several states and municipalities have requested information about developing and implementing a First Five program: Texas; Missouri; Georgia (DECAL)

 - i. Head Start eligible: 5,997
 - ii. First Steps 4K eligible: 4,297

- 2. Marketing First quarter marketing completed. On-going digital and social promotion continues; next push planned for June and July.
 - a. 1st quarter marketing included:
 - i. Radio Ads to run through March (English and Spanish versions)
 - ii. Digital ads (Facebook/Instagram/Google)
 - 1. Targeting a SC audience with an interest in early childhood and preschool
 - 2. Ads are changed out regularly to stay fresh
 - iii. Text messages Sent regularly through partner list (through SCETV Education and SCDHEC WIC offices)
 - iv. Peer to Peer marketing sharing information from vendor tables at professional conferences
 - v. Distributing informational materials with First Steps local partnershi ps for sharing
 - vi. Providing graphics and portal link to school districts, First Steps local partnerships and Head Start grantees to add to their websites
 - b. Palmetto Pre-K Enrollment Day (April 4)• agency-specific graphics and text were provided to the four government entities collaborating on the Palmetto Pre -K initiative. The graphics were shared in a statewide collective effort to encourage parents to enroll their children in preschool. First Steps county partnerships and local preschools shared the graphics further to expand the message reach.
